The City Council of Buffalo, IA met in special session on Wednesday, August 09, 1995, at 7:00 p.m. at City Hall with Mayor Phil C. Hoover presiding. Present were Councilmembers Tom Harland, Jr., Dave Kinsinger, Dick Nissen and Betty Walters. Absent, Josie Collins. Purpose of the special meeting was to interview an applicant for the vacant police patrolman position.

Council interviewed Brian Sanger. After discussion between Mr. Sanger, Mayor Hoover and Council, motion was made by Kinsinger and Harland, to approve Resolution #47-95, "A RESOLUTION TO HIRE BRIAN SANGER FOR THE POSITION OF BUFFALO PATROLMAN." Voting yes were Harland, Kinsinger, Nissen and Walters. Absent, Collins. Motion carried. Sanger will give two weeks notice and begin here on August 28 or 29. He will begin at \$9.60 per hour, be on a six months probation, possibly a .50¢ an hour raise then, with all benefits according to the Teamsters union contract.

Motion by Kinsinger and Walters to adjourn the meeting at 7:29 p.m. All present voted yes. Absent, Collins. Motion carried.
