AMENDMENT #400

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest to regulate the unnecessary use of jake brakes on vehicles;

THEREFORE, be it resolved that Section 2.1-2.0310 is hereby added to the Buffalo Municipal Code as follows:

2.1-2.0310. Jake brakes

No driver of any vehicle within the city limits of Buffalo equipped with jake brakes shall use such jake brakes unless it is needed in case of an emergency or public safety. The city shall place signs at both east Front Street and west Front Street describing this ordinance.

Full force and effect. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of passage and publication as required by law.

Repealer. This ordinance shall be construed to repeal any prior ordinance inconsistent herewith.

Severability of provisions. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed as separate, distinct, and independent provision as such holdings shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion hereof.
