

**CITY OF BUFFALO  
ORDINANCE NO. 410**

An Ordinance amending Sections 1-3.0104 and 1-3.0306 of the Municipal Code of the City of Buffalo relating to the Compensation for Elected Officials

**WHEREAS**, from time to time it is necessary to amend the Buffalo Municipal Code to reflect changes in compensation for elected officials.

**THEREFORE**, be it resolved that the following amendments are to be made to the Buffalo Municipal Code:

1. Section 1-3.0104 titled Compensation is hereby amended to read as follows:

**Section 1-3.0104 Compensation**

The salary of the mayor shall be established at one thousand six hundred dollars (\$1,600) annually, payable quarterly. Effective 1-1-2008 the compensation will be established at two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500). In addition the mayor shall receive compensation for one (1) private telephone and compensation for expenses incurred while performing the duties of the office outside the corporate limits, subject to council approval.

2. Section 1-3.0306 titled Compensation is hereby amended to read as follows:

**Section 1-3.0306 Compensation**

The compensation for each councilmember for each regular council meeting and each special council meeting shall be set at twenty-five dollars (\$25) for each meeting attended. Effective 1-1-2008 the compensation for council meetings will be set at forty dollars (\$40) for each meeting attended.

The compensation for each councilmember for each committee meeting that has been called for shall be set at ten dollars (\$10) for each meeting attended. Effective 1-1-2008 the compensation for committee meetings will be set at fifteen dollars (\$15) for each meeting attended.


**Full force and effect.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of passage and publication as required by law.

**Repealer.** This ordinance shall be construed to repeal any prior ordinance inconsistent herewith.

**Severability of provisions.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed as separate, distinct, and independent provision as such holdings shall not be affected the validity of the remaining portion hereof.


