

**CITY OF BUFFALO
ORDINANCE NO. 421**

An Ordinance amending Section 2.1-3.0219 (10) of the Municipal Code of the City of Buffalo relating to Tavern Regulations

WHEREAS, from time to time it is necessary to amend the Buffalo Municipal Code to ensure the public health and safety.

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the following amendment is to be made to the Buffalo Municipal Code:

1. Section 2.1-3.0219 (10) is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2.1-3.0219 Prohibited Sales and Acts

10. Failure to keep all doors and windows closed during Hours of Operation when there is excessive noise or music. Excessive noise is defined as any sound which annoys or disturbs a reasonable person of normal sensitivities. Any complaint by a resident of Buffalo or a City Official shall be directed to the Buffalo Police Department for investigation and enforcement of applicable noise and loudspeaker ordinances.


Full force and effect. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of passage and publication as required by law.

Repealer. This ordinance shall be construed to repeal any prior ordinance inconsistent herewith.


Severability of provisions. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed as separate, distinct, and independent provision as such holdings shall not be affected the validity of the remaining portion hereof.
