Ordinance 429

An Ordinance Creating 2.1-2.0609 of the Municipal Code of the City of Buffalo relating to stop signs

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of Buffalo to promote traffic safety, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Buffalo has determined there is a need to promote traffic safety at the intersection of Dodge and Third Street, and;

THEREFORE, the City of Buffalo hereby adopts the following Sections 2.1-2.0609 entitled Stop at Dodge and Third Street.

Section 2.1-2.0609- Stop at Dodge and Third Street. A stop sign shall be placed at this intersection facing south. Northbound traffic shall proceed with due caution.


Full force and effect- This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of passage and publication as required by law

Repealer- This ordinance shall be construed to repeal any prior ordinance inconsistent herewith

Severability of provisions- If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed as separate, distinct, and independent provision as such holdings shall not be affected the validity of the remaining portion hereof.
