

Minutes of the meeting of the Buffalo City Council, Iowa held on April 1, 2019 Meeting called to order by Mayor Doug Anderson, at 6:00 pm. Present Council members Dave Stickrod (Excused), Judy Hammons(Excused), Joe Buffington, Trent Adams, Sally Rodriguez, Public Works Director Art Horst, City Attorney William McCullough, City Engineer Mike Janecek, Police Chief TJ Behning and City Clerk Tanna Leonard.

Review of Consent Agenda- Agenda, Minutes (March 4, 2019) and claims, Motion by Rodriguez to approve the consent agenda. Seconded by Buffington and carried unanimously.

Public Input

Judy from Jud's Barge Inn requested to have the street closed for the motorcycle rally, similar to what she did last year. The Mayor requested that we she pay to have an additional officer on duty and that Chief Behning see that the City provided an additional officer during the event. Chief Behning will meet with Judy and someone from the Beach Pub to align the details.

Mallory Bartleson explained on behalf of Community Development that they have agreed to pay for the installation of a laundry facility. Mallory has been working on facilitating the donation of the equipment. She explained that currently children are coming to school with dirty clothing and changing when they arrive. A parent then takes the dirty clothes home and has them washed in time for them to change back into them before they go home. Approximately 70% of the other Davenport School locations have laundry facilities and the program increases student absenteeism and self-confidence.

Sally Rodriguez thanked everyone that had been helping with the flood including Brandy Harland with the Community Center, Scott County Waste Commission for gloves, Linwood Mining and Mineral for gloves and supplies, Shell and Dr.Pepper for water donations, Papa John's Pizza for donating food, Tommy's Café for doughnuts, Red Cross Volunteers and supporters for food and beverages, Davenport Central Track & Field, Palmer Rugby players, Davenport West Soccer, Davenport West Football, North Wildcat 12 U baseball, Davenport Cub and Boy Scouts and their families, and numerous Buffalo residents and families. Also apologies for anyone that she forgot to mention.

Salt Agreement

Motion by Rodriguez to approve the purchase of 120 tons of salt with 20 tons on reserve with the City of Davenport. Seconded by Adams and carried unanimously.

Motion by Rodriguez to table the bids for the roof at the BAC. Seconded by Adams and carried unanimously.

Training 19 Members participated in 2 hours of training on Incident Command/Scene size up. Six members spent 24 man-hours doing monthly crew duties.




