CONTRACTOR TO SUBMIT:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• COSESCO (Construction Site Erosion and Sediment Control) PERMIT APPLICATION• 2 PLOT PLANS – ONE WITH EROSION CONTROL MARKED• “SITE SPECIFIC STORM WATER POLLUTION PREVENTION PLAN” (MODIFIED FROM DEVELOPER’S PLAN FOR SPECIFIC LOT)• “NOTICE OF INTENT” (NPDES GENERAL PERMIT #2) – MODIFIED FROM DEVELOPER’S PLAN FOR SPECIFIC LOT

FEE FOR EROSION CONTROL DUE WHEN PERMIT IS READY TO BE ISSUED AND EROSION CONTROL PLAN HAS BEEN APPROVED	\$50
CONTRACTOR’S RESPONSIBILITY	IF CONTRACTOR IS NOT THE OWNER OF THE PROPERTY, IT IS HIS/HER RESPONSIBILITY TO BE SURE THE OWNER RECEIVES A COPY OF THE APPROVED COSESCO PERMIT
