- A. **Call meeting to order:** 6:02 pm
- B. **Roll Call**
 - a. **Park Board Members** – Troy Hass, Walt Basso, Eric Teel, and Brandy Harland
 - b. **City Council** – none
- C. **Public Input**

Adam Gerisher offered to make a plaque for the donation of the time and machinery for the boring of the cable lines for the park.
- D. **Restrooms**

Hass mentioned that the restroom walls were falling in. Per Josh Ferkel, they are currently condemned. Harland recommended asking Bi-State Masonry to come look at it and give suggestions on how to fix it. From there they will get bids.

Teel made a motion to help Buffalo Days with 4 Porta-Pottys and 1 hand wash station since the restrooms will be closed. Seconded by Basso and carried unanimously.
