To establish rules for safe, accessible, and responsible use of city-owned docks a Mississippi River, in alignment with Iowa DNR regulations.	long the

Section 3. Dock Use Regulations

• No overnight mooring or parking of watercraft

Applies to all users of public docks within Buffalo city limits.

- Prohibited activities: camping, sleeping, loitering, fueling, waste disposal, commercial activity, swimming/diving, alcohol consumption, amplified music, or disruptive behavior
- **Conduct requirements:** children under 12 must be with an adult; pets leashed; fishing allowed if it doesn't block access; ramps and tie-offs must remain clear
- Unloading zone: marked in yellow near the boat ramp; short-term use only for loading/unloading, brief tie-off, and vehicle parking; max use 15 minutes to maintain flow

Section 2. Applicability

Violations constitute a municipal infraction. Rules will be posted at all dock access points.
