I. SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

1. Definitions.

- (a)Property located at 802 3rd Street will be demolished and properly disposed of at the Scott County Waste Commission.
- (b)Contractor shall be responsible for disconnection of gas, water, and sewer connections.
 - 1. Water and sewer connections must be disconnected at the main and sewer lateral, and properly sealed by a licensed plumber.
 - 2. Street must be repaired to pre-condition status within 30 days of project end date.
- **2.** <u>Indemnifation</u>. The CONTRACTOR hereby agrees to indemnify and protect the CITY OF BUFFALO from all suits, claims, and actions brought against it, and all costs or damages, which the CITY OF BUFFALO may be put to by reason on injury, to the person or property of another in the execution of this contract, or the performance of said work, and to this end the CONTRACTOR agrees at all times hereunder to keep itself insured against liability in the following amounts:
 - 1. Workmen's Compensation as required by statute;
 - 2. Public Liability and Property Damage:

\$500,000 Each combined single incident

\$250,000 Motor Vehicle Bodily Injury per person

\$500,000 Each accident

\$1,000,000 Property damage

\$1,000,000 Excess, Blanket Basis, Liability Umbrella

Prior to demolition, the CONTRACTOR shall name the CITY as a co-insured and file with the CITY Clerk certificates of insurance evidencing such coverage. Such certificates, or their replacements, shall be continuously on file with the CITY during the full term of this contract.
